District Differently Abled Welfare Officer (DDAWO) launches Sri Arunodayam's 2018 'Special Mom' Awards and 'Special Mom Forum'

Kolathur, Chennai, India – December 18, 2017: Sri Arunodayam is a home for abandoned mentally challenged children in Kolathur, Chennai. Over the past 15 years, the home has provided a safe and caring environment for these children most of whom were abandoned in hospitals, crowded public places such as railway and bus stations, and at time even in dustbins! The organization works with the Department of Social Welfare, Child Welfare Committees, the Police and ChildLine in the rehabilitation of such children.

The story behind Sri Arunodayam's 'Special Mom' Award

Sri Arunodayam understands the extremely critical role of parents – especially mothers, in the healthy upbringing and development of children, more especially if they are 'special' children. However, in today's society, mothers of 'special' children are often misunderstood, discriminated against and judged. Some are even ostracized from their communities. Instead of fixing the problem the tendency is often to fix the blame, and almost always this falls on the mothers and their children, even though the children are the innocent victims in the whole scheme of things.

Sri Arunodayam believes that women who brave the odds for the sake of their special children are true unsung heroes and that is why the organization created this unique program with the aim of giving these mothers the recognition and honor that they truly deserve.

All Special Mom finalists automatically become members of this Forum – a project aimed at empowering mothers through joint collaboration, to advocate their issues at all levels of society with the help of the Forum. Such empowerment can help these mothers become powerful agents of change in society.

The Special Mom Forum was launched through an all-day program of **specialized workshops, tailored to cover issues faced by families of 'special' children**. Eminent faculty took sessions on **Government Policy & Schemes for the Disabled** (*Mr. Joseph Ravi - District Differently Abled Welfare Officer (DDAWO), Chennai*); **Government Resources & Entitlements for the Disability Sector** (*Mrs. Sheeba, Speech Therapist & Audiologist from the State Resource Training Center (SRTC)*); **Women's Health and Stress Management** (*Dr. Sumitra, President of the Tamil Nadu Woman Doctors Association*); **Psychiatric Disorders in Mental Retardation** (*Dr. Mythiri Manoharan, Psychiatrist from Kilpauk Medical Hospital*); and **Legal Counsel concerning Wills & Probates** (*Iyyappan Subramaniyan, Sri Arunodayam's Founder & Managing Trustee who is also an Advocate*).
