

Cyclone Gaja struck in the early hours of Friday, November 16, 2018. Its intense fury was felt most by the villages in the delta region of Tamil Nadu. As torrential rains and gales of up to 120 kmph whipped up a trail of destruction, lakhs of people became homeless, communication lines were disrupted, and crops decimated. It could take months or even years for these places to get back to normal!

**Most affected Districts** - Nagapattinam, Thanjavur, Thiruvarur, Pudukkottai, Cuddalore, Trichy and Ramanathapuram.

**Destruction:** Over 1 lakh electric poles, 1000 transformers, 201 electricity substations, 5000 boats, thousands of cattle and birds, over 18,000 hectares of coconut trees, and around 56,000 hectares of crops and trees.

- Melamarudhur (in Thiruthuraipoondi Taluk, Thiruvarur District)
  Areas selected based on extent of damage
  - Conducted surveys by speaking to families about their most critical needs.

- namely Edaiyur, Pandi, and

Focussed on 18 areas in 3 Panchayats

- Connected with donors and mobilised support
- Provided each family with 5 Kgs of Rice, ½ Kg Dhal, ½ Kg Oil, Biscuits, Tooth Paste, Candles, Bedsheets, and Mats. Tarpaulin sheets were provided to homes with damaged roofs
- Covered a total of **1585 families** across 3 Panchayats.
